SAFETY ON WHEELS

Roller Sneakers

"Heeling", the latest trend today, wheeled sneakers that let kids zip down sidewalks, across playgrounds and through mall crowds. They also do their fair share in sending them rolling into emergency rooms on a stretcher.

This new phenomenon is named after Heelys, the most popular brand that is being sold in 70 countries and has been recently landed atop BusinessWeek's annual list of fastest growing companies.

However, children all over the world are being treated for

even death were reported while wearing these shoes. None of these children were wearing protective gear.

Use the Right Gear

Just like in skateboarding which was discussed last month, it is important that if you're going to allow your kids to where these sneakers that they always wear proper protective gear:

- Never ride without a helmet. It should fit snugly and have a chinstrap. The helmet should not impair vision and hearing.
- Use additional protective gear, including slip-resistant shoes, pads for knees, elbows, and hips. Padded jackets, wrist braces, and special skating gloves can also help absorb the impact of a fall

Know How to Fall

Knowing how to fall safely can help reduce your chances of a serious injury. Here are some tips:

- When you fall, try to roll rather than absorb the force with your arms, wrists and hands.
- Try to land on the fleshy part of your body.
- Do your best to reflex your body during a fall. The stiffer you are, the greater chance of injury.

Don't Take Risks

Balancing on the wheels can be tricky, especially for novices. In the Irish study, most injuries were in new users and occurred with kids fell backward while trying to transfer their body weight. Something as small as a tiny piece of gravel getting caught up in the wheel can stop you cold.
